The Stuff of Legends



They are not yet as legendary as good old Tin Lizzy, the Ford T model, but in the US electric mobile scooters have long been a part of the street scene. And also in Germany these nimble movers are becoming more and more popular with disabled people.

With the recently developed T-Model, Mini Crosser presents a high-quality electric scooter combining great comfort with first-class design, thus perhaps creating the stuff of legends.

The Mini Crosser Company from the Danish town of Herning has been producing electric wheelchairs and scooters since 1981 and is even a market leader in the latter segment in Denmark and Sweden. All products are subject to constant testing by the Swedish Handicap Institute and the German TÜV (organization for safety standards certification). It took 2 years to develop the new T-Model and this period has resulted in numerous improvements

compared with the previous S-Model. Besides a new design with an integrated front light, the larger wheels of the T-Model raise it further from the ground thus enabling it to drive over kerbs up to 8 cm high.

Other improvements are an infinitely variable regulation of the angle of inclination of the handlebar and an optimized hydraulic

front fork of the kind seen on motorbikes. Thanks to universal transmission the steering of the Mini Crosser is extremely precise and direct. The individually suspended wheels also give good road contact and high gradient stability. The charger socket is now placed on the top of the handlebar so

that the user no longer has to bend down to operate the charger. As safety aspects played an important role in the development of the vehicle, the T-Model was subjected to crash tests and was approved for transportation of scooter and user in a minibus as long as a 4-point belt system is used for this purpose.

The electric mobile scooter, which can run at a speed of up to 15 km/h, is available in both a 3 and 4 wheel version and has a range of approx. 40 kilometres. Using bigger batteries it is possible to increase the range up to 80 kilometres. Thanks to the comprehensive accessories programme and various special seats the T-Model can be further adapted individually as required. Furthermore, there is a brand new waterproof cabin with built-in heater and windscreen wipers. With this equipment the Mini Crosser is certainly also an optimal vehicle for the start of the season for bad weather.
